

ROCKWOOD BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING

MARCH 15, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 7pm by President, Amy Jo Stout. In attendance was Amy Jo Stout, Caryohn Romesberg, James Ziegelmeier, Samantha Bartko, Mike Hutchison, Atty. Ben Carroll, Melissa Cramer, Samantha Bartko, Nancy Sleasman, and Kevin Yoder. There were three scheduled guests with only one attending.

Willbur Thomas representing the FNB property was letting the council know that the bank will be up for sale. He offered the property to the Borough first.

Nancy Sleasman made a motion to accept the minutes from the February 15<sup>th</sup> meeting. Samantha Bartko seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Kevin Yoder gave the Engineer report. NPDES permit update was given. We are looking for a report done by the EADS Group. The report is the 2007 LTCP. The Black Township pump station is slated to the 2023 schedule. The Broadway St. Extension is going to bid April 1<sup>st</sup>. for summer construction. The video inspection will be done within 2-3 weeks.

Melissa Cramer gave the police report. She updated the council on Officer John Loidici. He will be going to training again for the police dog. He will return on May 1<sup>st</sup>. Officer Robert Clark has the email up and running now. His body camera is also working.

Samantha Bartko gave the maintenance report. She touched on a few items that were on the activities list. Her and Mike Hutchison are going to pull together to produce an emergency operation file to be given to each of the council members. There will be one kept at the office too. That way if there is an emergency again all the essential information will be able to be found in one place.

Carroll Law did not have anything to comment or report on.

Under new business Nancy Sleasman talked about the SEP program. This will have to have a resolution made for so it can be voted on at the next meeting. This is where the hundred dollars that the council pays for the three full time employees for their health insurance. The insurance will cancel as of May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021. This money will then be put into Somerset Trust for the employees.

Yard sale day is slated for May 7<sup>th</sup>. Town cleanup will be done April 25<sup>th</sup> and May 9<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>. Recycling will not be done this year. Mike Hutchison made a motion to accept the quote for Streeting sweeping for the cost of \$2880.00. Jim Ziegelmeyer seconded the motion. All were in order.

Grove fest has been set for June 18<sup>th</sup> at 4 pm. There will be food trucks and music in addition to the firefighters and auxiliary having hamburgers and hotdogs. The Easter egg hunt will be held on April 16<sup>th</sup> at 1pm at the grove and it is sponsored by Rotary.
