Meeting Minutes

June 21, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. In attendance were Amy Jo Stout, Caryoln Romesberg, James Ziegliemier, Samantha Bartko, Kevin Yoder, Nancy Sleasman, Attorney Ben Carroll, Mike Hutchison, Melissa Cramer and two guests Julie Cramer and Larry Mazer. Absent from the meeting was Chris Sipe. Officer John Loidici showed up around halfway through the meeting.

James Ziegliemier made a motion to accept the minutes from the May 17th meeting and Nancy Sleasman seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Samantha Bartko made a motion to accept the minutes from the "Special" meeting on May 23, 2022. James Ziegliemier seconded it. All were in favor.

Julie Cramer addressed the Council first asking if there could be a better way to get bills paid going forward, in reference to the Veteran's and Memorial Park. She feels that it will be to long of a wait time to pay bills after the money that the Borough has now is all used up. She also raised the question as to why the Borough refused to help get another grant for \$45,000 for the next phase of the park. Amy Jo Stout stated she called three council members regarding the park. Samantha Bartko, Mike Hutchison, James Ziegliemier, and Nancy Sleasman all said they knew anything about it the grant for the park. They said they could have had a special meeting if they had known about the grant. Larry Mazer was at the meeting to give an update on the Community Action Group. Grove Fest was a hit. There were around 250 people in and out all day long. The Farmer's Market is growing every week with new vendors.

Kevin Yoder gave the Engineer Report. He spoke to Steve Spokart about the Broadway St. Extension project. Steve Spokart told Kevin that the Environmental Clearance was done last week, and the project can move forward and will be put out to bid shortly. Kevin Yoder attended a meeting that morning about the Main St. Streetscape Project. The meeting was with Chris Hall from PennDOT, and it was an informative type of meeting. There will be another meeting on August 30, 2022, it will be a more scoping meeting looking at flood reviews and other more in-depth items. Nancy Sleasman made a motion to accept the \$11,800 for videoing the sewer system from White Oak to Chestnut St. James Ziegliemier seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Melissa Cramer gave the police report. John is to return to work. There will be no police dog here. Samantha Bartko will get a quote on a fan for downstairs in the police department.

Samantha Bartko gave Maintenance Report. Street sweeping has been done. The company they eventually got to do the job was from Donegal. They were headed back through this way from doing a job in Bedford County, so the borough only had a half a day to prepare for them. Nancy Sleasman made a motion to retroactively replace the street sweeper we had lined up earlier and replace them with the one from Donegal Transport Corp. and to accept their quote of \$3000.00. Mike Hutchison seconded it. All were in favor. Nancy Sleasman made a motion to replace the Bridge St. Pump Station at the cost of \$6583.00 that was quoted by Industrial Service Solutions and James Ziegliemier seconded it. All were in favor. Samantha Bartko made a motion to purchase a rebuild kit in the amount of \$4200.00 from the same company so that there would be a spare one. Mike Hutchison seconded it. All were in favor.

James Ziegliemier made a motion to pay the monthly bills. Mike Hutchison seconded it. All were in favor. The meeting went to executive session at 9:17 pm. They returned from executive session and the meeting was adjourned at 10:35 pm.
