

## Meeting Minutes

July 18, 2023

Darr Construction will be starting work on August 16, 2023. Larry Mazer had sent a update on the Community Action group and Caryoln Romesberg made copies for everyone's packets.

Kevin Yoder gave the Engineers report. DEP is satisfied with the paperwork submitted in May. The boss will have the final say on the NPDES permit. The streetscape project has been through the safety review and the design concept now it will be bid out on August 24, 2023, for a 2025 proposed project start. The grove project is still being finalized through DCNR.

Samantha Bartko gave the police report. The police handled 28 calls and were at GroveFest the entire day.

Ken Milcarzyk gave the maintenance report. He presented to the council the bid for Vegetation management in the amount of \$1272. Samantha Bartko made a motion to accept the bid and Nancy Sleasman seconded the bid. All were in favor. The flood control inspection is on August 21, 2023, at 10:00 am.

The Carroll Law update was given by Attorney Ben Carroll. We went to executive session at 7:42 for discussion of the Borough's alley between the Wright's and Ray's house on Broadway. We returned to regular session at 7:58 pm. Upon returning to regular session Nancy Sleasman made a motion to ratify a lien in the amount of \$4600.00 against the Wright's which would recoup the money the Borough paid out to fix the alley and the solicitors fees for filing. Samantha Bartko second the motion. All were in favor.

Under new business, Samantha Bartko made a motion to pay the monthly bills. Nancy Sleasman seconded it. All were in favor.
