

MEETING MINUTES

JANUARY 16, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 6:58 pm. In attendance was James Zieglemeier, Samantha Bartko, Caryoln Romesberg, Officer Robert Clark, Andy Miller, Carter Bower, Mike Hutchison, Larry Phillips, Adam Hemminger, Melissa Cramer and Attorney Ben Carroll. Todd Berkey was here as a guest.

Samantha Bartko made a motion to accept the minutes from both the December 19, 2023 meeting and the January 2, 2024 meeting. Mike Hutchison seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Guest Todd Berkey was here to express his opinion of how things were managed during the recent snow/rain event.

The NPDES permit was issued on January 11th, 2024. It will need to be advertised in Pa Bulletin. January 20th to February 19th so that people can comment. Larry Phillips gave the update on the Grove Project. He was hoping that the surveying could be done next week. His goal is to have a bid package put together and to get it put out for bid by early Spring. He finalized the restroom and ADA items, did the site plan. The bid package will need to be looked at by the Solicitor before advertised. The Black Township Project was next. The Redevelopment Authority only got five responses from the residents. Steve Spokart is preparing for a second round of letters to go out so we can try to get CBDG money for the project.

There was no maintenance report. Ken Milcarzyk commented on the snow/rain event that Todd Berkey came to the meeting about "We did the best we could do."

The police answered ten calls since the last meeting. Samantha Bartko made a motion to purchase Axon Body Camera for the price of \$8322.42 over a 60-month contract. Andy Miller seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Attorney Carroll mentioned the Roberta Miller property on Broadway. Ken Carolus is willing to pay \$1500.00 for it if the County tears it down. Samantha Bartko made a motion to authorize Attorney Carroll to work on a contract for this project. Mike Hutchison seconded the motion. All were in favor. Samantha Bartko made a motion to have Attorney Carroll send a letter to Kevin Yoder to have him explain his charges for the bills that the Borough got. They want dates and details of work done. Mike Hutchison seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Under new business, the community action group plans to have a Music on Main event on April 20th to coincide with Earth Day. The event will be like the Christmas event they had in December. There will be food trucks and live entertainment from a live band. Samantha Bartko made a motion to donate \$600.00 to pay for the band. Carter Bower seconded the motion. All were in favor. Samantha Bartko made a motion to approve the hanging of a banner on the poles by the Veteran's and Memorial Park for the dedication event to be held on May 25th, 2024. Mike Hutchison seconded the motion. All were in favor. Samantha Bartko made a motion to pay the monthly bills. Carter Bower seconded the motion. All were in favor.
