

MINUTES

SEPTEMBER 16, 2025

The meeting was called to order with the saying of the pledge of allegiance. In attendance were Caryoln Romesberg, James Zieglemeier, Andrew Miller, Adam Hemminger, Todd Skowron, Ken Milcarzyk, Attorney Ben Carroll, Chief Robert Clark, Mike Hutchison, and Carter Bower. Absent were Samantha Bartko and Melissa Cramer. We were supposed to have a guest, but he cancelled.

Andrew Miller made a motion to accept the minutes from the August 19th meeting.

The Grove Project had a need for a change order. Carter Bower made a motion to approve the change order. Andrew Miller seconded the motion. All were in favor. The motion to approve the fourth payment in the amount of \$79544.65 was made by Andrew Miller, Carter Bower seconded it. All were in favor. There has been no change in the Black Township Project. The Engineers are going to make a cost analysis of the project, then can then look for grants and funding from PENNVEST. The Streetscape Project is slated to begin in April of 2026. The engineers met with New Enterprise and got cost estimates of what each of the streets in town would cost to be repaved. The engineers let Borough Council there is a statewide LSA grant to help with projects, and they will need to apply by November 30, 2025.

There were forty-three calls to the police department and six to PSP. Chief Rober Clark has been updating the contacts in his phone. He also added the newest ordinances to the website. The cameras have been installed the one in the Borough building is set to record from 8:00 am until 4:30 pm. The camera outside is set for 24 hours a day.

The maintenance department gave a summary of what they have been working on. There was a request for a handicapped parking spot to be marked and a sign to be installed at 828 Broadway. Andrew Miller made a motion to approve the parking spot, and Carter Bower seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Carter Bower made a motion to pay the monthly bills. Mike Hutchison seconded the motion. Andrew Miller abstained from voting pointing out an incorrect check that was made to his wife but should have been made out to Rockwood PTO. The school agreement was being presented on September 16th at their school board meeting.

Andrew Miller made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:19 and Carter Bower seconded the motion, and the Council went into executive session.
